





# Tiles of Lucca

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This is an addendum to those who have chosen to use “V” Block Trimmer instead of the attached paper templates or Tri Recs Tools for this pattern. Use the “Cutting the Strips” instructions here to cut correct number of strips of each size. Also included are all the steps that may have differences between using the other tools vs. the “V” Block Trimmer.

## CUTTING THE STRIPS

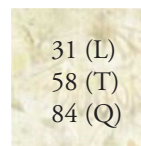
The 1 ½" Fabric A strips are for the inner border, the 1 ¾" Fabric C strips are for the outer border, and 2 ¼" Fabric C strips are for the binding.

## SUBCUTTING THE STRIPS

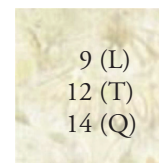
### Fabric B

• 4" strips: While strips are folded selvage to selvage, subcut them to 80 (L), 140 (T), or 196 A1V triangles using the “V” Block Trimmer for Block A. Due to folded strips, the same number of mirrored triangles are cut for a grand total of 160/240/392 triangles.

- 4" strips: Cut a total of 31 (L), 58 (T), or 84 (Q) 4" squares (24/48/72 for Block B and 7/10/12 for Block C).
- 4 ½" strips: Cut a total of 9 (L), 12 (T), or 14 (Q) 4 ½" squares (7/10/12 for Block C and 2 each for Block D).

## Fabric C

- 3 1/2" strips: Cut a total of 12 (L), 24 (T), or 36 (Q) 3 1/2" squares for Block B.

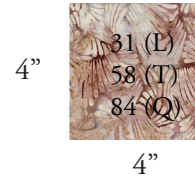

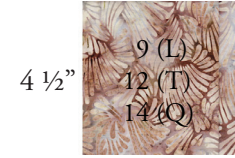
- 4" strips: Sub-cut a total of 80 (L), 140 (T), or 196 (Q) A2V triangles using the "V" Block Trimmer for Block A (can be cut while folded).



- 4" strips: Cut a total of 31 (L), 58 (T), or 84 (Q) 4" squares (24/48/72 for Block B and 7/10/12 for Block C).
- 4 1/2" strip: Cut a total of 9 (L), 12 (T), or 14 (Q) 4 1/2" squares (7/10/12 for Block C and 2 for Block D).

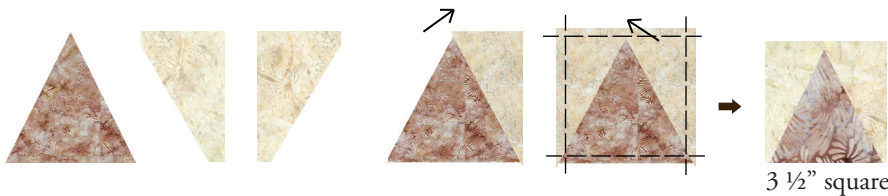

## BLOCK A - NEED 20 (L), 35 (T), OR 49 (Q) BLOCKS

- 2 In-Between ("V" Block) Units: Make 80 (L), 140 (T), or 196 (Q) units by sewing a Fabric B A1V triangle and its mirror to both sides of Fabric C A2V triangle. Press after each seam is sewn, and then trim to 3 1/2" square using the "V" Block Trimmer.
